

## “Witches of Eastwick” Props Hire List

- 4 x washing lines for "Dirty Laundry". (You can see these in the show photograph at [http://www.yorklight.com/img\\_lib/photos/19123918\\_witches25.jpg](http://www.yorklight.com/img_lib/photos/19123918_witches25.jpg)). They are steel frames approx 1.8m long x 2m high, on good quality castors (so that the cast can dance with them - most companies have choreographed them into the dance number). The actual washing lines are sprung, so that cast members hiding behind sheets on the lines can pull them down to appear over the top of the sheets. Weighted sheets and dolly pegs are supplied.
- Red cart with large sack of "clay" for Alex
- Red girl's scooter (large size!) for Little Girl
- Two alternate magic cookie jars - one round with flat mirror, one square with curved mirror
- Wooden tray with red velvet lining for carrying cookie jar. Tray has compartments for all the items mentioned in the "scraps of tin..." song lyrics (so that the girls can scoop them up quickly enough to stay in time with the music), and there is a plastic tool case containing all the small items required.
- Rubber frying pan. Custom-made for the show, this is a very realistic copy of an American cast-iron skillet, and can safely be used to hit Felicia on the head. Great if you want to make the death scene dramatic rather than comic. [NB - this is a VERY expensive prop... it had to be specially made for us in the USA and needs treating with great care. Please ensure it is only used for staged action, and not for fooling around!]
- Two aluminium frying pans, one with face moulding in the base (as if Clyde has hit Felicia so hard he has bent the pan round her face). An alternative to the rubber pan. Obviously, Clyde must not actually hit Felicia, and has to swap pans behind the kitchen counter to get the comic effect.
- 7 matching 1950s period black Bakelite phone handsets for "Eastwick on the Line"
- 7 fluorescent coloured telephone handsets (alternative to period items for above)
- Red telephone (1960s style) for Darryl
- Wooden ironing board and 1950s iron for "Creepy Darryl's" scene
- 4 matching red/glitter tennis rackets for tennis scene. Darryl's racket has a pyrotechnic launcher built in for the exploding tennis ball effect. You must supply your own flash paper and flash cotton - unfortunately, **we cannot legally supply these**.
- 12 inch collapsing candle
- 4 x polycarbonate martini glasses (unbreakable)
- 4 x brandy glasses (glass) and "Napoleon Brandy" bottle
- Chivas Regal bottle

- 3 x good quality cardboard dress boxes for Fidel to carry
- 3 large photo albums for use as "Malefica". Books have bike lights buried inside so that they appear internally illuminated.
- Female rag doll for Little Girl
- Voodoo doll of Darryl in evening dress
- 3 cushions in blue / green / yellow to go on Alex's red sofa (cushion colours match the bubbie figures above Alex's door on the Scenic Projects set)
- 2 red velvet upholstered footstools (used in the bedroom scene - the bed in the Scenic Projects set is too high for the girls to climb onto without an extra step).
- 1950s red vinyl suitcase for Jennifer

We can also arrange for a complete 1950s black bakelite phone, if you are keen to get period detail correct (extra cost).

This is the basic set of props that are specific to "Witches"... please ask if you are looking for other items, as we have a large props collection, and may well be able to help.

**Hire fee for the full set of props is £200.**

**You will need to arrange transport - note that the washing lines need a transit-sized van or trailer at least 2m long and 2.1m high.**
